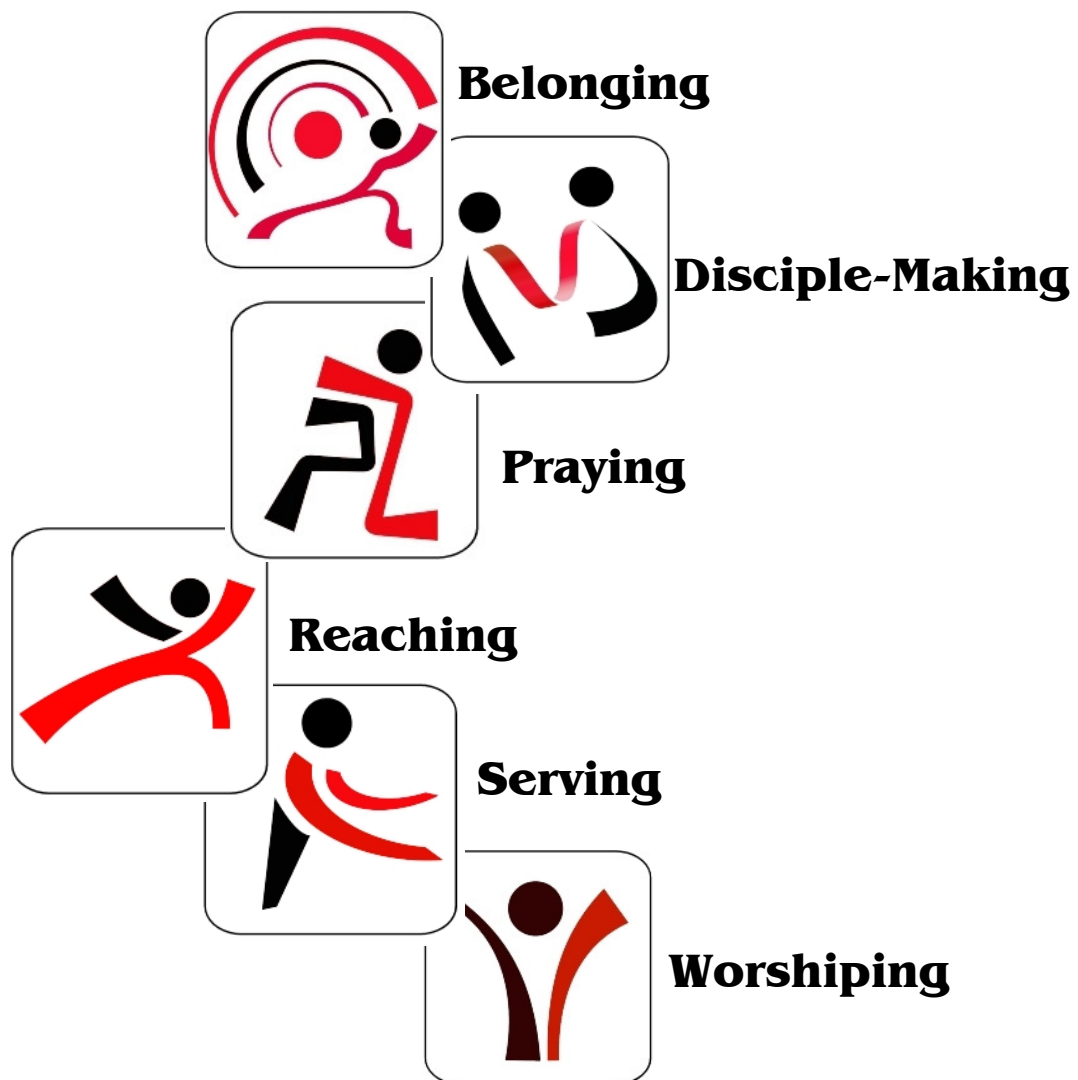


Ministry Opportunities
